- Listen to and value your views
- Maintain a positive and supportive environment which encourages mutual respect and the expression of children's views

AS PARENT/CARER I WILL AGREE TO:

- Celebrate my child's successes and achievements at school
- Give some time to talk and listen to my child and give positive support to efforts and progress my child has made
- Let the school know about any concerns or problems as soon as they occur
- Allow a member of staff to administer medicine following instructions provided on the school's medication form.
- Listen to my child to read daily and provide books and opportunities that will help with learning
- Support the school's policy and guidelines on home learning and spellings.
- Attend meetings to discuss my child's progress
- Attend workshops and curriculum evenings to learn about new policies and teaching developments
- Support the school's policies on behaviour
- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and punctually keeping absences to a minimum
- Inform the school by 8.30am if my child is absent
- Ensure that my child has appropriate school clothing and equipment
- Agree to allow my child to go on local trips with their class and school staff during the school day
- Abide by the school's policy on mobile phones and devices that connect to the internet.
