ParentPay Debt

As already mentioned in the July newsletter, please can we ask that every effort be made to clear ParentPay debts. The school debt has reduced to **£1776.20** but is obviously still extremely high and so please can we ask that every effort be made to clear your **£0.00!** Therefore, from September, if your debt reaches **£30.00** (not including voucher payments) your ParentPay account will be frozen which means that you will be unable to pay for any trips and your child will be unable to have school lunches or attend wraparound care until the debt is paid in full.



If you pay using childcare vouchers or the government scheme, it might be an idea to make an August payment so that your account is in credit rather than arrears.

Year 6 - Please can we ask that all accounts are cleared ASAP. All school lunches have been added for the week so your account is completely up to date. Any debt left will be chased throughout the holidays and if your child has a sibling, the debt will be moved to their account.

Year 2 - Please note, that from September when your child moves to Year 3 you will be charged for school lunches unless your child receives free school meals. The lunch charge is £2.25 per day so please make sure your child's ParentPay account is in credit for lunches in September. Please note that **ALL** ParentPay accounts should always show a credit or a £0.00 balance. Please click [here](#) to make a payment.
