Breakfast Club Charges

We have had a few questions this week about breakfast club charges and how to secure a place for your child. Breakfast club opens at 7:30am each morning, you do not need to book in advance. Children should be taken to the school hall where breakfast club is held and enter via the outside double doors that will be open.

The prices are set out below:

£5 from 7:30am onwards including breakfast (please note there is no reduction in price if your child does not wish to eat any breakfast)

£2 from 8:30am onwards (please note that breakfast is not included in the price)
