
We would be grateful for any donations of tissues. If these could be handed to the staff in your child's year group, we would be very grateful.

# **Anti-Bullying Week @ Greenvale**

During the week of 13th November, Greenvale celebrated Anti-bullying week. This year's theme was 'Make a noise about bullying'. We held a themed assembly during the week which included showing the following video - Click here

During the assembly, we spoke to the children about what is meant by the term bullying. We will often use the acronym 'STOP' which stands for 'Several Times on Purpose'. We shared the many different forms that bullying behaviour can take and more importantly, what we can do should we ever feel that we or others are victims of such behaviour.

We also made the distinction between bullying and conflict which is where two or more children can fall out and be unkind to one another. Whilst unkind, this would not necessarily equate to bullying behaviour.



Should you have concerns, in the first instance please contact your child's class teacher.

We also have the 'Worried about something' button on the school website where children can take the lead and log their own worries or concerns.
