
## Things to Listen or Read This Week



## Important Notices

#### **Suspected Case of Scarlet Fever**

Further to the email sent earlier in the week, we have a suspected case of Scarlet Fever at Greenvale which has not as of yet been confirmed. Please click <a href="here">here</a> for NHS guidance and information. Please seek medical advice if you have any concerns regarding your child's health.

#### **HMRC Tax-Free Childcare**

There are currently only 16 families using the tax-free childcare service set up by HMRC to pay for wraparound care. If eligible, you'll set up an online childcare account for your child and for every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay in £2 to use to pay. Please note that this is different to the voucher scheme system set up through parent's employers. If your child attends Breakfast Club or Afters and you have not set up a tax-free childcare account, please click <a href="here">here</a> to understand the benefits of doing so.

#### Late Collection Charge

We have had an increasing number of children being collected late from school. Please note that from Monday onwards, children will be taken straight to Afters if not collected on time and you will be charged £6.00 (the first Afters session charge). We would therefore suggest you ensure that at least one Greenvale parent is added to Arbor who is authorised to collect your child should you be running late.
