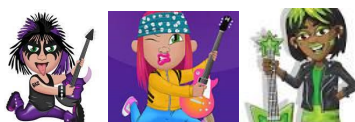

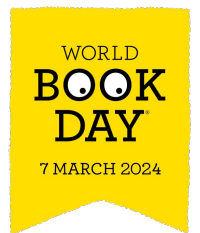


Parent Consultations
