# Christmas Lunches – Frequently Asked Questions

## How do I order my child's Christmas lunch?

Please order a hot/vegetarian school lunch for your child on Arbor as usual before the deadline of 12pm on **Wednesday 25th November**. Please note that no other meal options will be available to your child on the day but will show as options on Arbor as we unfortunately cannot delete them.

## How many adults can come to lunch?

Unfortunately we only have room for 1 adult per child for each lunch session.

## How do I book and pay for an adult lunch?

Please book an adult lunch by logging into your child's Arbor account either by using the Parent Portal or Parent Portal App before the deadline of 12pm on **Wednesday 25th November**. The cost of an adult lunch is **£6.00**. Please **DO NOT** add funds to your child's meals on Arbor.

**Parent Portal:** From the main Parent Portal page, scroll down to School Shop section.

- Click School Shop in your Quick Actions.
- Click on the child's name and select School Shop from the left-hand menu.
- To view your purchased items, return to your homepage, then select the student.
- Go to *Quick Actions > Payments > Invoices* from the left-hand menu, where you can see the purchases

**Parent Portal App:** Go to your main menu and select School Shop.

- The *School Shop* page will list any items that can be purchased for the child. Click on the item.
- To view your purchased items, click the menu item in the bottom left, scroll down to *School Shop* and select *Invoices*.

## What if I do not wish to eat a lunch?

Parents and carers are still welcome to come along and sit with their children even if they do not wish to eat a lunch or have missed the booking deadline. There is no need to book a place if this is the case.

## What if I have 2 children in the same key stage/same day?

If you have two children in the same key stage with lunch on the same day, please order 1 adult lunch and enjoy your main course with one child and your dessert with the other.

## Where do we go?

Christmas lunch will be in the school hall. Please wait outside the double doors to the hall near the bottom of the office steps. The doors will be opened when it is your child's lunch session time. Please bear with us if you are coming to the second sitting as we may experience some delays in vacating everyone from the hall and setting up for the next session. We will aim to do this as quickly as possible.

## When is the deadline to book and pay for lunch?

The deadline to book and pay for an adult lunch is 12pm on **Wednesday 25th November**. The deadline to book a child lunch is 12pm on **Wednesday 25th November**.

# Christmas Parties – Frequently Asked Questions

## How do I order my child's School Christmas party lunch?

Please order a cold deli option for your child 48 hours in advance on Arbor as usual.

Please note that children are unable to have a hot lunch/jacket potato/pasta on their Christmas party day as they will be eating in classrooms but will show as options on Arbor as we unfortunately cannot delete them.

## Can my child have a packed lunch from home?

Yes children are welcome to bring in a packed lunch from home. Please update Arbor to confirm this is the case.
